Please find attached the amended letter in relation to the last published inspection date of 2024.

There was no minute taken of the meeting, however the actions from the meeting were as follows:

- CEC to send over a revised letter outlining the reason for the end of partnership and include information that we will continue to fund existing children for duration of their entitlement . We will also fund existing children who would be eligible from January 2026 for the duration of their entitlement.
- CEC to send over a copy of the letter that will be provided to existing Parents.
- No new children will be funded from April.

Good evening

Thanks for getting this over to me.

There are a few errors in the letters, and I thought best to let you know just now to allow this to be changed before it is issued out to parents.

You refer to us being inspected on 30th May 2025 in both the letter to me and the letter to parents. This was not the date of our last inspection, that was the 2024 inspection. We were inspected on 31st July this year and the report is not yet finalised or published.

I don't believe we are allowed to announce the grades for this report until it is published and our date for responding is 10th September therefore, I would imagine it will go live around the end of September. At this time, it remains a draft report.

The 5 questions were graded as 4,3,4,3,3 within the draft report therefore expected grades under the 4 areas will remain at 3,4,3, 3. While they have indicated progress throughout in every area since the last inspection, due to focus areas for improvement not being embedded yet, they were not recommending changing the other grades of adequate as of yet. As shared during the discussion, there were no requirements made and the areas for improvement remained focused on staff deployment. Overall, it was a very positive inspection, highlighting lots of progress and this is another reason this termination notice has come as a shock.

I have sent over the draft report to [REDACTED] previously.

I do have a couple of questions perhaps you can answer or direct me to where i can get the answers.

Will we be sent over minutes from todays meeting? It would helpful to have these. We didn't take a minute.

Actions were to

- Send a revised letter outlining the reason for the end of partnership and include information that we will continue to fund existing children for the duration of their entitlement. We will also fund children who are eligible from January 2026 for the duration of their entitlement.
- We will also let them see a copy of the letter we plan to send to parents for feedback before we issue it.
- No new children will be funded from April.

Do I continue to attend events such leading the strategy after December? Only providers in partnership can attend council events.

While the partnership is ending, as you are continuing to fund children through to when they go to school or move to another provider Yes. do we still receive visits etc from [REDACTED]? No. Once out of partnership you will not receive access to this resource.
