Wee Macks Nursery – Extension to the End of Partnership Process.

I am writing to notify you that the end of partnership process for the Termination of your Partnership Agreement with the City of Edinburgh Council to deliver funded early learning and childcare, will be extended from **31/12/2025**, to the end date of your current temporary Partnership Agreement which is **12 August 2026**.

As previously agreed, existing funded children will continue to be funded along with children who become eligible for funded hours from January 2026. We will also agree to fund children who become eligible from April 2026. However, we will not provide funding for children who become eligible from August 2026, unless Wee Macks Nursery is able to demonstrate full compliance with the National Standard for Funded Early Learning and Childcare and has received evaluations of Good or better from the Care Inspectorate across all quality indicators.

I'm sure you will appreciate this extension to the end of partnership process and would hope that you can make the improvements required to provide high quality early learning and childcare for the children attending Wee Macks Nursery.
