The [Road Safety Delivery Plan 2025/26 – Six-month update Report to the Transport and Environment Committee on Thursday, 13 November 2025](#) gave details of the Proposed New School Travel Audit Process, based on collaboration with the schools to support them in creating their own independent School Travel Plans. Meanwhile, officers will audit each school and prepare a School Travel Audit document of proposed infrastructure improvements. An audit programme will be prepared each year, with schools being assessed once every 5-years. Project plans will then be prepared, and delivery will be prioritised based on a priority scoring matrix that will deliver road safety improvements to those schools that need it most, first. The School Travel Audit for Frogston Primary School is scheduled to be undertaken in this Financial Year.
