I refer to your request for permission to hold this event on the dates mentioned above. Your application has been reviewed by the relevant Council teams. Estates have confirmed the area has been booked and please note the additional comments below:

Public Safety:

- We have no concerns with permission being granted for this event.

Roads Events:

- The Citywide Road Events Team have assessed this application and in principle there are no known issues or conflicts affecting this event taking place.
- Although it was not noted on the application form, we have since received a request for a temporary traffic regulation order (TTRO) which will be progressed and invoiced accordingly.

Noise Team:

- In principle we do not have concerns about this event – we would expect music noise / announcements to be controlled so as not to disturb nearby residents. Appropriate noise conditions will be placed on the relevant civic licences.

Licensing:

- No comments received.

License applications should be made 60 days in advance, an additional 20% “late fee” charge is payable for any temporary licence application received within 42 days of the date the license is due to start.

Failure to obtain all required licences and permissions will invalidate this permission.
