

61048 Full Bid Submission and Evaluation – Harmony Fire Ltd.

The Full Tender Submission: A complete copy of the bid submitted by Harmony Fire Ltd, including all technical appendices, methodology statements, and project delivery plans.

The Project Programme: The final version of the delivery schedule (Gantt chart) submitted with the bid and any updated versions agreed upon at the contract commencement.

The Final Contract: A copy of the signed contract or 'Call-off' agreement, specifically the Specification of Works and the Service Level Agreements (SLAs).

The Council acknowledges that there is a clear public interest in the release of the requested information to ensure that there is transparency and accountability in the actions of the City of Edinburgh Council in relation to the way in which it does business. However, if the Council were to release this information into the public domain, it would cause substantial harm to the commercial interests of the service provider, as it could provide external providers with an unfair advantage when competing for Council contracts and work. The Council therefore finds that the public interest in providing this information is outweighed by the Council's need to maintain confidentiality on costs in line with the need to provide best value for money and ensuring fair, open and transparent competition. Disclosure of commercially sensitive information would cause substantial harm to both the Council seeking to obtain the best value for the citizens of Edinburgh and the supplier.
