In light of the recent motion to temporarily ban development of AI data centres in the city by Cllr Mumford I am writing to respectfully request that you request a hearing (deadline Monday the 23rd at 1pm) for the planned data centre at Hermiston 25/03978/PAN (4.2 on agenda 25 March development management subcommittee). I believe to include this in your agenda is in direct contradiction

I strongly believe there is a need a debate about the process as the premise for the PPiP application has changed. The main exception from the LDP claimed is that the data centre is "Green". There must be a debate on this, and an EIA must be included on this application.
