Just a bit of feedback from our site visit previous to my annual leave.

Myself and [REDACTED] the area Engineer visited site and agreed that the applicants suggestion of being the other side of the bollards was in fact workable. This is to be in the area pictured in the attached Image (68).

The discussion I had with the applicant led to them confirming they would then be able to remove the caravan every night which then hopefully resolves one of the issues previously discussed. When I asked about where it would go, the applicant stated that this could be moved to somewhere else in local streets overnight.

This then leaves us with needing a solution for power. The applicants potential new location we don't believe would resolve the noise issues with a generator however the plans for the cable needs work. Ultimately the primary issue will be the gates pictures in images 66 and 67. I think it has already been stated by neighbours in complaints to licensing that they wouldn't be keen to have cables under their steps. The applicant mentioned on the phone they think that there is enough of a lip on the steps for the cable to be tucked underneath however upon site inspection I don't agree. I have discussed this with [REDACTED] and should the applicant be willing to get permission from the neighbours to give some sort of small protection at each step that was tucked directly up against the wall allowing neighbours to use their steps with no potential of tripping then I don't think we would be too worried about that. The additional cable crossover of the footway if kept within a brightly coloured wheelchair compliant cable protector we think this would be an improvement on what is there currently and would suffice for this license providing it is removed daily along with the caravan so that there are no issues with visibility at night.
