How many fines have been issued.

The following fixed penalty notices (FPN) have been issued over the past 10 years.

The reason for the fine.

The two FPNs issued in 2018/28 related to the sale of tobacco products to persons under 18 years of age.

Thirty-two of the FPNs issued in 2024/25 period related to the sale of nicotine vapour products to persons under 18 years of age.

One FPN issued in 2024/25 period related to carrying on a tobacco or nicotine vapour product business whilst not being registered to do so.

Thirteen FPNs issued in 2025/26 period all related to the sale of nicotine vapour products to persons under 18 years of age

Their Value

The standard rate set for a fixed penalty notice starts at £200, reduced to £150 if paid within 14 days. Our records show 6 FPNs were not paid during the period 2024/25. All other FPNs were paid at the discounted rate.

The total value of fines issued over the period requested is £6300.00
