

61279 Silverknowes Road East to Marine Drive

I would like to know the cost/monies spent on the installation, removal and replacement of the spaces for people provisions and cycle lanes from Silverknowes Road East to Marine Drive in Edinburgh.

The original recorded installation cost for the Silverknowes Road Scheme through the Spaces from People programme in 2021 is £39,605. The cost relates to the installation of the scheme but excludes the cost of the segregation units which were purchased separately at the beginning of the Spaces from People programme for all projects. We do not hold a separate record of the cost of the segregation units for each project.

Where we are unable to provide the segregation units cost, the Council is relying on the exception under regulation 10(4)(a) of the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004.

Please note that this letter constitutes a formal notice under regulation 13 of the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004.

The following costs are for the alterations that have taken place over the past year.

Contractor - £108,501.43

City of Edinburgh Council Workshop team - £15,399.52

Site Supervision - £18,403.00

Road Safety Audit - £2,083.00

Road Orders - £1,663.36

Neighbourhood Notifications – £123.04

Traffic Surveys - £795.00

I would also like to know about accidents before and after these installations along with those on Silverknowes Parkway:

- the number of accidents/incidents recorded as taking place in and around cycle lanes with bollards and bases since they were installed on Silverknowes Parkway, Silverknowes Road North to the Prom and South to Silverknowes Road East mentioned.
- the number of accidents/incidents recorded taking place on Silverknowes Parkway, Silverknowes Road North to the Prom and South to Silverknowes Road East for five years prior to the installation of the cycle lanes.

Based on an installation date at the start of 2021, there have been no insurance claims for this location relating to the bollards.

In the previous five years prior to this date, starting 2017, our Insurance Services received one claim that was for vehicle damage due to a pothole in the road at Silverknowes Parkway.

On 02/11/2025 we received a report of an accident/incident at the junction of Silverknowes Road and Silverknowes Hill. There is no record of an insurance claim in relation to this.
