

61329 Planning Enforcement 25/00335/ENCOMP

Please limit the search to records created or held between 1 May 2025 and 31 July 2025 in relation to: - enforcement case 25/00335/ENCOMP; and - any associated consideration of whether the as-built scaffold or advertisement differed from the approved drawings for 25/00059/ADV.

Please provide the following recorded information:

1. All site inspection photographs, site notes, measurements, annotations, file notes, and internal reports created for or used in 25/00335/ENCOMP, including material from the site inspection referred to in the enforcement report.
2. Any recorded information showing what dimensions or physical differences were actually taken into account in 25/00335/ENCOMP when assessing the scaffold/shroud as built, including whether officers considered width, height, or both.
3. Any correspondence, notes, or recorded information referring to Edinburgh Trams and/or the Council's Road Permit and Occupation team that was relied on in concluding that the change to the scaffold extent had occurred and in assessing whether enforcement action was expedient.
4. Any recorded information showing why the case was closed as a minor breach with no action, including any note or discussion of whether amended drawings, a retrospective application, or further enforcement action were considered. If no recorded measurements, calculations, or dimensional analysis were held beyond the enforcement report itself, please confirm that.
