

## 61424 Council's Procurement Spend

According to recent reporting, the Council's total procurement spend was approximately £815 million, with roughly £685 million attributed to regulated contracts.

I am seeking clarity on the remaining £130 million of 'below-threshold' spend.

Please provide:

The total value of spend attributed specifically to 'Quick Quote' tenders issued via Public Contracts Scotland (PCS).

The City of Edinburgh Council is unable to provide this value as spend is not recorded on PCS. Not all below-threshold contracts are awarded through PCS, and PCS marks mini-competition procedures called off from Framework agreements as 'Quick Quote', thereby giving inaccurate information.

The total value of 'below-threshold' spend (contracts under £50,000 for goods/services) awarded to suppliers with a registered EH postcode.

We are unable to answer this question as spend is not segregated by contract type/regulated and non-regulated.
