

61797 Evidence of Fine

I am writing in relation to Penalty Notice EZ11085633 issued for the vehicle registration NU62 OSO on the 15th April 2026 at 17:31 within Edinburgh's LEZ.

I request the following:

Proof of Emissions Non-Compliance

Clear, factual evidence that the vehicle did not meet the required emission standards on the date in question, including any official reports, test results or certificates that validate this claim.

The process for determining whether a contravention has occurred is carried out automatically via the UK Government's Joint Air Quality Unit, which compares the emissions data of the vehicle to the minimum emissions standards required to comply with The Low Emission Zones (Emission Standards, Exemptions and Enforcement) (Scotland) Regulations 2021. Only vehicles that do not comply with the standards will be issued with a PCN based on the rules and compliance standards set out in the Regulations. Proof of Adequate Signage

Evidence that the Low Emission Zone was clearly marked and that signage and road markings indicating the LEZ boundaries were visible and fully compliant with legal requirements at the time and location of the alleged contravention.

Road markings are not legally required. All of Edinburgh's LEZ signage complies with the legal standards and is regularly checked. There is no requirement for the Council to prove signage compliance at the exact dates and times of specific contraventions, but the Regulations do make provision for the recipient of a Penalty Charge Notice to make a representation and provide evidence if they believe that the signage was not clearly visible.

Calibration Certificates for the Camera

Since the penalty notice was issued based on a camera recording, I request the relevant calibration certificates for the camera that captured the vehicle. This will ensure the camera's operation and accuracy meet required standards.

Edinburgh's LEZ enforcement cameras are ministerially approved devices, certified by Transport Scotland under Part 4 of The Low Emission Zones (Scotland) Regulations 2021. Please note that Schedule 6 of the regulations specifies device requirements, which have been met to secure certification.

Validation Certificates

If the vehicle is deemed non-compliant, I request any relevant validation certificates or supporting information verifying the status of the vehicle's emissions, including records of inspection or emissions testing.
