The City of Edinburgh Council raise awareness and provide information about the Togetherness online parenting courses to parents and carers to through our Supporting Families webpages and also through emails and newsletters organised by the Parent and Carer Support team. Any parent or carer can register for the modules as self-study and use the Scottish Government funded codes to access the courses for free.
