I refer to the planning enforcement case referenced above.

As discussed on Friday 29 August 2025 at the site, I have now had the opportunity to check the planning history.

The check established that there is no planning permission in place and that planning permission had been refused under application reference 22/00734/FUL for the erection of a temporary structure for cafe use to be located on the south side of St Mary's Cathedral. Whilst this is not the location where your café is situated, it does provide a form of precedent in terms of this type of development being unacceptable. Furthermore, a check of the street trader licensing register reveals that you had a licence in 2022 but this expired in June 2023. No further licence applications appear to have been made. Given this, you have been operating without planning permission and a licence.

In view of the above, it is requested that you cease trading and remove the tables and chairs and wagon. I shall allow two weeks from the date of this e-mail. A failure to comply with this request may result in formal enforcement action being initiated.
