Request for copies of Edinburgh Farmers Market's (i) licence and (ii) public liability insurance.

(i) Licence information as per below (to be read with the attachments).

The City of Edinburgh Council hereby grants a Market Operator's Licence as detailed below to the person named to operate the premises specified as a market, all in terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982. The responsible manager of the premises (if any) shall be the person so specified. The licence is granted subject to the conditions specified and shall be in force for the period or until the date specified subject to the provisions of paragraph 11 of the Schedule 1 of the said Act.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

1. The opening hours of the premises will be:

09:00-15:00

2. The licence may be granted subject to the licence holder ensuring that market traders handling open foods comply with the 'Minimum Standard for Mobile Food Businesses'. Environmental Health may carry out unannounced visits in respect of health and safety, and food hygiene to ensure traders are compliant with relevant legislation. It will be the responsibility of the licence holder to ensure market traders are compliant with relevant legislation

3. the applicant does not unreasonably obstruct road or footway users, affect their safety or obstruct access to public seating or waste bins. The applicant is reminded that any type of advertisement board including an A-board is not permitted to be placed on a public footway.

(ii) Public liability insurance (PLI) – It is a standard licence condition for the licence holder to have public liability insurance cover for their events however evidence of this is not required to be presented as part of the licence application process.
