

62153 Zone 6 Resident Parking Permits During 2023, 2024 and 2025

The number of zone 6 resident parking permits which were issued during 2023, 2024 and 2025.

We can advise that the number of live permits in the April of each requested year were 1,784 for 2023, 1,761 for 2024 and 1,777 for 2025. We are unable to provide you with the number issued in each year because it is not held by the Council.

The estimated number of visitor parking spaces available in zone 6 during 2023, 2024 and 2025.

Please note that there are no on-street parking bays specifically allocated to visitors, although visitors may pay to park in paid or shared parking places, and may use visitor permits (where held) to park in shared or permit parking places. Is there a limit on the number of parking permits which could ultimately be issued within zone 6 based on the number of available spaces?

Whilst there is no numerical limit on parking permits allocated to each Controlled Parking Zone, permit eligibility is restricted in accordance with the [amended eligibility criteria](#) approved by the Council's Transport and Environment Committee.

For the new developments between no 33 and 67 Eyre Place (odd numbers only) how many zone 6 parking permits have been issued?

6 permits.

The planning permission for new developments on Eyre place stated that no zone 6 parking permits would be available for these properties, but understand permits will/could be issued (based on seller information in adverts). Have there been any other new developments within zone 6 in the past 2 years which had planning permissions stating no permits would be issued and have subsequently issued parking permits?

Other than Eyre Place, a maximum of 1 permit may be issued to properties at 1 Canon Street.

For the new housing development in the former RBS site, will or could any zone 6 parking permits be issued or is there a restriction on that site being able to access any residential parking permits?
