Please provide a copy of minutes, emails etc between council officials and externally with regards to the planning and parade for Hearts winning the SPFL?

I can confirm that such records are held, however, they shall not be provided on this occasion. Information is withheld under Section 39(1) of FOISA.

Who was the officer responsible for overall delivery?

The Council's Corporate Director of Customer and Corporate Services was responsible for event delivery over the weekend, supported by Senior Manager Event and Public Space Operations and several council teams. The Council had agreed responsibility for a proportion of the route for Sunday, whilst Heart of Midlothian Football Club were responsible for the stadium as well as the surrounding streets for Saturday and Sunday.

What was the total amount of spend agreed?

The agreed spend to deliver safe plans relating to the Council's responsibilities was £57,868 (excluding VAT).

With the event being cancelled what was the actual spend?

To The City of Edinburgh Council, the cost of cancellation was, approximately £17,966.25 (excluding VAT). This covers medical, security, waste/cleansing, hostile vehicle mitigation and temporary toilets.

Figures for roads are not available.

What was the staff hours spent on this event?

96 hours (Public Safety, Security, Facilities Management and Waste/Cleansing. Our Roads teams do not keep separate records of staff hours.
