Hi both,

[REDACTED] and I visited earlier on today (1/5/22 - EVU 073806). Unfortunately the usage of the garden is very much a civil matter. The premises have access to it via their fire exit and have been storing their bins as well as stock inside locked cabinets in the area within the curtilage (but not blocking) of the door. When we entered the rear area the door alarm did indeed trigger inside the premises. As far as we could see the CCTV points directly down and appears to only cover the fire door and not any other private property.

Given that space is at a premium inside the premises and I don't believe businesses are allowed to store receptacles on the public highway I was unable to find a workable solution for the removal of the bins.

Staff will also now be instructed to not use the area for smoking and will instead be directed to the front of the premises.
