The Council operates a no compulsory redundancy pledge. The Council's Organisational Change Policy sets out the Council's managing change consultation requirements which would potentially lead to redeployment or voluntary redundancy. No information is held on early retirement 'pay-offs' or 'bonuses'. The Council does not operate any policy provision regarding 'early retirement pay-offs' or 'bonuses'.

There have been no Chief Officers who have been made compulsorily redundant by the Council in the last five years. The City of Edinburgh Council does not pay bonuses to employees.
