

62535 Juniper Green and Edinburgh Council Parking Initiatives

A list of all initiatives and total cost for each, associated with Juniper green and Edinburgh council parking initiatives over the entirety of Juniper Green School being there. This refers to all school travel parking initiatives since 2009.

No such initiatives have been identified by our Parking or Road Safety teams.

How many Parking tickets issued since the yellow lines came into force and how many were given to residents?

The total number of Penalty Charge Notices (PCN's) issued for the period from 03/07/2016 to 03/07/2026:

Baberton Mains Wynd - 11

Baberton Avenue – 1

Woodhall Terrace – 0

It is not possible to determine how many of these PCNs were issued to residents. The DVLA only share details of the keeper of a vehicle with the Council when a PCN is escalated to a Notice to Owner. Keepers' addresses are shared to enable the Council to post the Notices.

When the parking lines came into force, I assume the Council made a proposal for when Parking Attendants should be allocated and what times to support such an initiative – I'd like copies of this proposal.
