

## 62584 P1/P2 Composite Class Allocation Policy - Newcraighall Primary School

The specific criteria, policy guidelines, and operational frameworks used by Newcraighall Primary School and the City of Edinburgh Council to determine which pupils are allocated to a composite class (specifically the P1/P2 split) versus a single-year cohort (the straight P2 class).
