

63173 E-bike Crime

A breakdown of the number of complaints made to the council about any activity involving e-bikes, e-scooters, e-dirtbikes from January 2024 to the present date. Divided by month and area/council ward is preferable.

We have identified four complaints submitted through our central Customer Services team related to e-bikes as follows:

October 2024 – General dissatisfaction with VOI e-bike scheme referencing Dalry Road and Leith Walk.

March 2026 – Complaint regarding the VOI e-bike scheme discounts. Not related to a specific area of Edinburgh.

April 2026 – Report of safety hazard resulting from the current VOI e-bike hub placement at Warriston Road/Logie Green Road. Also, Deliveroo riders entering one-way system at this location in the wrong direction.

May 2026 – Misplaced VOI e-bike report. No location provided.

There may be more relevant complaint records held by Police Scotland.

How many police requests for CCTV footage has the council processed monthly regarding e-bike incidents since January 2024?

Police requests for CCTV recordings are not categorised in terms of their contents, such as 'related to e-bike incidents'.
