Really only one option and that is Viewforth, I wouldn't want to put a cost on the construction of a coach layby until PU apparatus depths are known. It would be beneficial to get a trial pit so the depths could be checked, Road Ops could possibly assist. If a PU does need dropped/diverted then this would need to be discussed with the individual PUs which may result in the costs increasing significantly.
