Thanks for copying me into the emails and apologies for not responding sooner.

I have caught up with colleagues today on my return from annual leave and the project is being progressed.

The next stage is that a structural survey will be carried out to determine the retaining wall adjacent to the pavement is constructed with the appropriate strength to support the proposed changes. Should this survey prove positive then colleagues in the Council's Transport Contracts and Design Team will finalise the design and deliver the project. There are likely to be roads construction consents required but not planning permission. If the survey determines the project can proceed then, once the design has been progressed further, we will be able to provide a more accurate estimate of the timeline for delivery of the project and will share this with the school community.
