We do not publish details of outstanding debts, and this information will not be provided to you. Commercially sensitive information such as company debts cannot be released. The Council's view is that disclosure of this information to the public at large is likely to substantially prejudice the commercial interests of the businesses, as placing into the public domain their financial position and debts may negatively impact their business. These businesses have no expectation that such financial information will be published.

Please also note that to identify whether each business has paid, and the total amount paid by these businesses, in the requested period would require a manual search of each account. As there are several hundred businesses in the area identified within your request, the cost of retrieving, locating and providing this information would far exceed the statutory maximum of £600.
