Legal Errors in ETRO 21/29D

I would like to know how council officers were notified of legal errors in ETRO 21/29D, including any of the following pieces of information:

The date that officers were made aware of legal errors.

An email from a member of the public raising concerns about the descriptions of some of the restrictions in ETRO 21/29D was received by the Council on Sunday 19 April 2026.

Officers subsequently identified that the descriptions for the two prohibitions of motor vehicles trialled at Braid Avenue and Hermitage Gardens were incorrect on Monday 20 April. For Canaan Lane, the incorrect description was identified by officers on Monday 4 May.

The source of the notification - internal staff (if so which department), legal advisors, or a member of the public.
