- financial year 2026/27 to the date of this request.

For the avoidance of doubt, this request includes accommodation obtained through formal procurement, the Council's Temporary Accommodation & Associated Services Flexible Purchasing System (including CT0627), direct award, framework arrangements, spot purchasing, nightly purchasing, block bookings, or any other purchasing or commissioning mechanism.
